- Prescriptions includes:
 - Schedule II to V controlled substances
- Pet medications
- Liquids, ointments, syrups, elixirs
- Prescription patches
- Aerosol cans
- Inhalers

- Chemotherapy prescriptions
- Auto-injectors e.g. EpiPen® or insulin pens
- Vials e.g. methotrexate, insulin
- Vitamins
- Over-the-counter medications

X NOT ACCEPTED

- Sharps needles, syringes or lancets
- Illegal drugs including Schedule I controlled substances or marijuana
- Non-phamaceutical items (e.g. hydrogen peroxide, thermometers)
