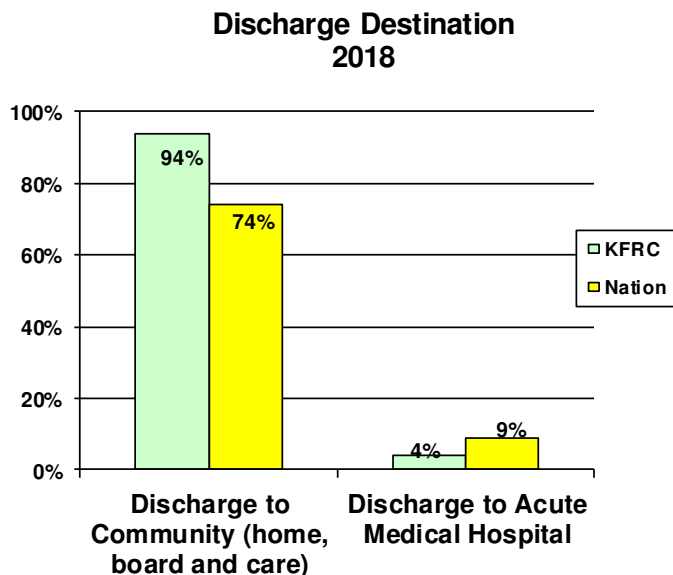


Stroke Specialty Program

The Acute Stroke Specialty Program at Kaiser Foundation Rehabilitation Center is an individualized, outcome-driven and integrated program that addresses the complicated needs of persons who have experienced a stroke. Our program focuses on preventing further impairment and reducing disability to promote an optimal quality of life for our members. Our goal is to achieve functional outcomes focused on home and community integration and enhancement of self worth and engagement in productive activities. We served 728 individuals with stroke in 2018. The average number of days our patients stayed in the inpatient acute rehabilitation program was 15 days.

98% of our patients surveyed with stroke reported that they were satisfied or very satisfied after their stay at Kaiser Foundation Rehabilitation Center in 2018.



In addition, we are proud to report that our patients have a higher rate of returning to the community when compared to other rehabilitation facilities in the nation.

87% of our patients met the goals for improving their functioning.
