At our Antioch Medical Center, members receive high-quality care in a healing environment. They can access a wide variety of primary and specialty services, including adult medicine, pediatrics, oncology, cardiology, ambulatory surgery, orthopedics, urology, and more. The facility has:

- 150 beds—all in private rooms
- 8 private labor and delivery rooms
- 36 Emergency Department treatment bays
- 11 high-tech surgical suites
- A meditation labyrinth on the grounds

An environmentally friendly medical center

The Antioch Medical Center was built with the environment in mind—it's 15 percent more energy-efficient than the industry benchmark requires. Here's how a green facility helps promote the well-being of our members, caregivers, and the community:

- New building materials don't release harmful or irritating gases.
- Rubber floors reduce the risk of slipping and don't require harsh cleaning chemicals.
- Carpeting is made with recycled materials and won't release cancer-causing chemicals.
- Large windows and open interiors bring in natural light and reduce the need for artificial lighting.
- Landscaping includes native, drought-resistant plants that require little to no watering.

Smart planning creates comfort and convenience

Thoughtful design, comfortable furnishings, and inspiring artwork help our expert caregivers maintain a restful environment. A small rooftop garden atop the hospital's third floor includes bamboo and leafy vines in planters that are positioned to provide privacy for the windows of the mother/child unit, offering a pleasant view from the physical therapy area. Spacious visiting areas and meditative healing gardens give friends and family relaxing places to gather. Patients can be visited 24 hours a day—and each room is family friendly, featuring pull-out beds for overnight stays and wireless Internet access.
