Approximately 400 physicians provide care at the Walnut Creek Medical Center, which offers a range of specialized services such as cosmetic dermatology, chemical dependency, and health education. In 2003, the facility opened a state-of-the-art, 32,000-square-foot Emergency Department—the largest in Contra Costa County. The facility has:

- 233 beds
- 36-bed maternity unit
- 10 high-tech surgical suites
- 52 Emergency Department treatment bays
- Nearby occupational health center

When special medical attention is required, our facilities offer centers where physician specialists focus on a particular area such as spinal surgery or cardiovascular care.
