POSTOPERATIVE INSTRUCTIONS: PROBE AND IRRIGATION OF TEAR DUCT

This procedure is done under general anesthesia in the Operating Room. Some special precautions should be taken after surgery.

- 1. Your child should be fed slowly at first. Start with clear liquids such as ice chips or apple juice no more than 1/2 cup. Observe for 15 minutes before giving more. Watch for any vomiting.
- 2. Let your child sleep if he/she chooses. It is not unusual for several hours to elapse before usual liveliness returns (or for more drowsiness or alertness to recur later in the 1st day).
- 3. Apply the eye medication if directed by your physician.
- 4. Keep your appointment as directed.
- 5. It is not unusual to detect orange-yellow stains around the eye, nose or urine. It is the Fluorescein Stain used briefly to irrigate the tear duct system to insure proper opening. It may faintly stain a diaper permanently, however.

There is fever above 100°F

Persistent vomiting

Persistent unusual sleepiness

Eye pain
