

Telephone

The telephone in your apartment is hooked up to the medical center's system. To place outside calls, dial 9, and the number you want. Please charge long distance calls to your telephone credit card, or place them collect. Please use 911 for paramedics or emergency rescue

The front door intercom rings through the telephone. To open the front door from your apartment, press "0." For your convenience, some important medical center telephone numbers are listed below. To reach any listed department, just dial the five-digit extension.

Welcome

To make your stay with us as comfortable as possible, we've prepared this brochure to help you get to know the neighborhood as well as the services provided in your temporary "home away from home."

We hope you will use your apartment as you would any second home. If you don't like being alone for long periods of time, we encourage you to have a relative or friend stay with you during your visit.

When You Arrive You'll be staying at the Kaiser Permanente Kenmore Apartments, 1630 N. Kenmore Ave., one block from the Radiation Oncology Center at 4950 Sunset Blvd.

The building is locked for security, so you may pick-up your apartment and garage keys from the resident manager in his or her office. While picking up your keys, feel free to park temporarily on the street by the main entrance.

The Residence

The Kaiser Permanente Kenmore
Apartments are reserved for patients
who live in the outlying areas of
Southern California where distance
makes it impossible to commute for
treatments on a daily basis. The threestory building has an elevator and
39 apartments. Each unit has a living
room, TV, a bedroom with twin beds,
a bathroom with a tub and shower,
and a kitchen equipped with essential
cooking utensils, dishes, and silverware.

Housekeeping

Each apartment is cleaned before it is occupied along with bed linens, towels, and lightweight thermal blankets provided by our hospital's housekeeping staff.

Each Wednesday morning fresh linen is available in the conference room on the 1st floor. To help you keep your apartment tidy, a vacuum cleaner is available on each floor. Washers and dryers are also located on each floor.

Pets

We do welcome service animals.

Regrettably, we cannot permit dogs,
cats, or other pets in the apartments or in
vehicles. Please make arrangements for
the care of your pets while you're away
from home.

What to Bring

You might want to bring soap, dishcloths, cleanser, dishwashing soap, and paper goods. You might also want to have your small electric kitchen appliances with you, such as blenders or coffee makers. For assured comfort, do bring your own pillows. An extra comforter or non-electric blanket is also advisable during the winter months.

No Smoking in Rooms

Smoking is not permitted in the Kenmore Apartments, on balcony's or garage, or within any facility on the medical campus.

Community Rooms

The Community Room, which faces the patio on the first floor, is a pleasant place to meet and chat with other people, watch TV or to use w.

Local Places
